Handover, visitors, checks and manager oversight are not side admin. They are part of the live care picture around the child.



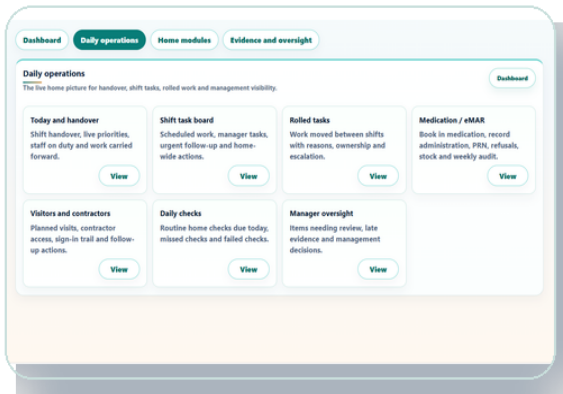

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A home does not run from one form

Children's homes work through dozens of small operational decisions: who is on duty, what was handed over, what task rolled forward, which visitor arrived, which check failed and what the manager needs to review.

Those details become meaningful when they sit near the daily record instead of being buried in separate places.

The My Home direction

The My Home area groups daily operations, home modules, visitors, daily checks and oversight into a more practical working dashboard.

The design is intentionally simple: cards, routes and status cues so staff can get to the right area without a small treasure hunt through the interface.

What this supports

For managers, it supports a clearer handover brief. For practitioners, it reduces the number of places they have to check. For auditors, it helps show how routine work becomes evidence.
